

Archery Blended Learning

This Blended Learning path is recommended for volunteers, age 18 and up, who have previously been qualified as an archery instructor and need to renew their certification.

COST: \$69 online course fee + \$5 GSNCA fee for in-person portion.

Recertification: \$30 for online course fee + \$5 GSNCA fee for in-person portion.

What is Blended Learning?

Girl Scouts of North-Central Alabama requires that outdoor program certifications include hands-on training and an in-person instructor skills verification. Blended Learning is the term used to describe a training course where part of the course is provided online and the other part is in-person and hands-on.

How do I complete Blended Learning for Archery Instructor and RE-Certification?

1. Contact Tonya Sails tsails@girlscoutsnca.org to register for Girl Scouts of North-Central Alabama's Blended **Course (also called Re-Certification AER Camp Archery Instructor)**
2. GO to <http://www.archeryinstructorcertification.com/lms/>
3. From the course menu at the bottom of the page, choose the "Camp Archery Instructor Recertification"
4. Register and pay the course fee.
5. Complete the provided Camp Archery Instructor course and the online test.
6. Submit a copy of your certificate to tsails@girlscoutsnca.org. You will be notified of the dates and locations Learning Archery Instructor RE-Certification (BLArchRecert) and pay the \$5 Blended Learning fee.
7. Attend the scheduled in-person portion and successfully complete the instructor skills verification (held on for the in-person portion. These will be provided at GSNCA camp properties in January 2016 and again in April 2016; the same day).
