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I agree that the following statements are true, and I will follow them. They will be in effect each time the Girl Scout Troop is together for any reason.

I WILL

Behave according to the Promise and Law, which includes and is not exclusive to the following:

- 1. **Be respectful of others.** I will remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine. I will not disparage or make fun of the ideas and thoughts of others. I will try not to offend or hurt anyone else with my thoughts and ideas.
- 2. **Be respectful of authority.** I will uphold the decisions of the troop, the Service Unit, GSNCA, and GSUSA. I will follow instructions that are given to me to the best of my ability.
- 3. **Be considerate.** I will treat others as I would like to be treated at all times.
- 4. **Be honest.** I will be truthful at all times in what I say and do.
- 5. **Be fair.** I will treat everyone equally.
- 6. **Be helpful.** I will be supportive and do what I can to be useful to others.
- 7. **Be responsible for what I say and do.** While there may be disagreements or conflicts outside the Girl Scout space and time, girls must refrain from bringing that issue into the Girl Scout meeting in order to facilitate a safe space for all.

GIRL SCOUT LAW

If by words and actions I do not work to uphold these statements:

- 1. On my 1st offense, I agree that I will not be able to attend the next troop meeting or event.
 - a. (Written documentation will be sent home).
- 2. On my **2**nd **offense**, I will not be able to attend any troop meeting or events for 1 month.
 - a. (Written documentation will be sent home).
- 3. On my 3^{rd} offense, my parent/guardian will be required to attend all troop meetings/events with me.
- 4. On my **4**th **offense**, I will be asked to leave the troop.
