Volunteer Years of Service	The Years of Volunteer Service Pin recognizes a registered adult Girl Scout for years of active volunteer service at five year intervals. Girl Scouts of North-Central Alabama provides the pin for members starting at the 10th year. Members who have completed 5 years of active volunteer service may purchase the pin through our GSNCA shops or they may be purchased by the troop, service unit, or anyone as a gift to the member.	This recognition is for active service as a registered, adult volunteer. Partnered directly with girls in any pathway to implement the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE) through use of the National Program Portfolio. All service-team members have met all requirements and expectations of the positions held. The service-delivery team has significantly contributed to meeting one or more of the council's mission-delivery goals. Participates in Product Programs and Community Service.
