





How does it work?



First Aid and CPR Training

\$35/ Person

Min. 5/ Max. 12

- Camp Trico-October 12th
- Blended- 2 hours virtual + 2hours in person

This training will certify you in First Aid, CPR, and AED for Adults and Pediatrics, and will qualify you for the First Aider role.

Every troop should have at least one First Aider and your certificate must be renewed every two years. This certification allows your troop to do many more outdoor activities including overnight trips and camping (when combined with camp training).



What time: line up is at 11:30 parade at 12:00


