In 1914, Girl Scout uniforms began to be manufactured. Juliette Gordon Low ordered a stock of blue uniforms, with khaki to be sent only by special request. But the girls preferred khaki—they were developing an interest in outdoor activities and considered it more practical for hiking, picnicking, and camping.
